NEW YORK – Anthony Kearns, and his two colleagues from the sensational touring group, The Irish Tenors, will be guest performers on “The Martha Stewart Show” on Wednesday, March 17, 2010, it was announced.

The Irish Tenors are currently on a whirlwind, eight-city tour with final performances on March 17 in Raleigh, NC and on March 19 in Charlotte, NC.

The Irish Tenors became a world-wide sensation in 1999 as Ireland’s most famous touring musicians, second only to U2. Kearns, the group’s only original member, is increasingly in demand as a solo artist. He performs concerts with piano accompaniment in a recital format, as a guest soloist with some of the world’s finest symphony orchestras, and on opera stages in Europe and America.
